Deddington Library – ‘YOUR village library in YOUR community’

Deddington Library has served Deddington Parish and surrounding villages since it was opened in 1956 by JRR Tolkien, author of *The Hobbit* and *Lord of the Rings*. It has survived many challenges since then but none quite like the challenge faced in 2012 when Oxfordshire County Council (OCC) budget cuts were so severe the only options were to close branch libraries or reduce funding and rely on volunteer help and community fundraising to meet the running costs.

The Friends of Deddington Library (FoDL) were formed, and fundraising began. A subscription-based membership to FoDL was introduced and is essential to support the ongoing costs FoDL are legally obliged to pay to OCC to support the library.

We rely heavily on fundraising to meet the annual shortfall in subscription income. The Deddington Parish Calendar is one such fundraiser. However, due to increased running costs over the last 3 years our subscription income and Parish Calendar no longer meet these costs, and we will have a funding gap to address in the future, if we don't act now.

Deddington Library provides a huge resource to the local community; free to use internet ready computers linked to many resources, such as Ancestry and Find My Past, as well as audio books, Wi-Fi, Rhyme times, reading challenges and of course, regularly changing book stock! Deddington Primary School have weekly class visits, numerous Reading Groups are supported, and the Home Library Service delivers books to elderly and housebound people in their own homes, a lifeline for so many.

Library members can borrow FREE eBooks and eAudiobooks from Borrowbox. You can also borrow eBooks, eAudiobooks, eComics and eMagazines from Libby. Both of these services have an app and a website. If you're not a member of the library, you can join online, also FREE! <https://www.oxfordshire.gov.uk/residents/libraries/using-library/join-library>
